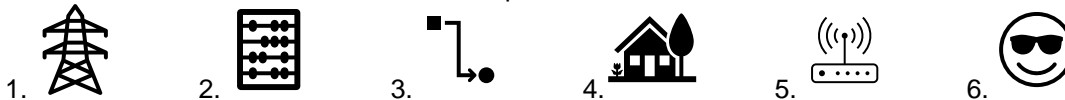

The Big Picture

We're building a future-proof fiber network to connect the Methow Valley. Construction is happening in stages, and every customer will get service as soon as their neighborhood is complete. We're starting with an ARPA funded build in the upper valley, and working our way strategically outward from there.

How Fiber Construction Works

Backbone → Cabinets → Distribution Lines → Drops to Homes → Internal Network → Go Time - Service Active!



Happening Now

Router installs for indoor activation are happening now in Phase 1 and 2!

- Please verify your name and address with the installer. Routers are programmed to user and location.
- This is a taxpayer funded standard install. Crews have a full schedule and need to keep moving to stay within budget and timeline. If you want a custom install longer than the standard time, this can be scheduled later and paid for separately.

Burn In Period – We're testing the lines and all the connections. Please leave the routers plugged into power to enable the testing. When testing is complete, your section will go live. We'll let you know when it happens!
